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THINK IT OVER

Oregon Initiators of freak laws are out to take the prize with a measure to be put on the ballot at the coming election to amend the constitution so as to limit the rate of interest on open accounts to 4 per cent and contract rate to 5 per cent.

An Eastern Oregon stockman recently said to his banker, "We will fix you fellows at the next election so we will get money cheaper."

"You owe some \$20,000 at this bank do you not?" said the banker.

"Yes, I do," said the stockman.

"Well," said the banker, "If by any chance such a fool law as this should pass, you would get notice in the next mail to pay up your loan. The money which you are using is loaned to you by our bank for eastern clients as you know very well a small bank like ours could not loan you \$20,000. If this bill passes no person would loan money in Oregon any more than you would sell cattle here if a law were passed limiting the price you could sell for in this state to one-half or two-thirds what you could get outside the state. It would be the same with all industry. Nobody would loan money at 4 and 5 per cent in Oregon. The borrower is the man who would suffer for the man loaning money could lend elsewhere while the borrower in Oregon would be without funds."

TO GET MORE SHIPS

Portland, Oregon, Nov. 25th, 1919.

At the meeting of The Board of Directors of The Loyal Legion of Loggers and Lumbermen just terminated the influence and support of the organization was assured the Northwest on the matter of procuring more bottoms for Pacific Coast shippers in the adoption of the following resolution, and the determination to put the force of the organization's 40,000 members behind it:

Resolution: Whereas, It is apparent that the free movement of lumber is seriously impaired by the growing lack of available tonnage on the Pacific, and,

Whereas, The production of ships during the emergency period in the Pacific Coast shipyards was far in excess of the production on the Atlantic Coast, and,

Whereas, It is our understanding that these Pacific Coast built ships are in the main loaded for European ports and after discharge of initial cargo are almost without exception continued in the Atlantic Coast Trade, and,

Whereas, A continuance of this apparently unfair discrimination against the section of the country producing these ships will seriously interfere with the ability of the mills to market their products, especially in view of the serious car shortage,

Therefore, Be it Resolved, That this organization lend every assistance possible to aid in the correction of this injustice and to urge upon the officials of the U. S. Shipping Board, and our Representatives in Congress that they do all in their power to afford immediate relief.
