

Sale of Siletz Indian Lands

The following list of Indian lands located on the Siletz Indian Reservation, Lincoln County, Oregon, is offered for sale under existing laws.

Each bid must be accompanied by a duly certified check, certificate of deposit or cashier's check on some solvent bank, payable to the order of Edwin L. Chalcraft, Superintendent, for ten per cent (10%) of each bid.

The successful bidders will be called upon to pay the costs incurred in advertising this land for sale, and the receipt of a bid will be considered evidence that the bidder accepts this requirement.

The patent issued to purchasers will contain a provision to the effect that there is reserved from the lands granted a right of way for ditches and canals constructed under authority of the United States.

Deferred payments at six per cent interest can generally be arranged, provided a payment of not less than twenty-five per cent of the purchase price is made when the bid is accepted.
