### NOTICE TO MARINERS

Yaquina Bay, Captain. Captain E. C. J. Smith and Captain Samuelson report that the North Channel marked by Outside Bar Buoy, 3, at the entrance to Yaquina Bay is shoaling and that it should not be used by vessels. Also that the shoal off the north jetty is extending from the northward close to the Fairway Buoy and that the bear water is found at present by entering well to the south of the south end of Reef Buoy, 1, passing some distance to the southward of the Fairway Buoy and then following close along the north side of the south jetty. A minimum depth of 14 feet at low water is reported.

### WARNING ISSUED BY DISTRICT ATTORNEY

While the political pot is boiling, strange plots may be brewing to take last-minute advantage of candidates and measures. To counteract this possibility, District Attorney Evans last night issued a timely warning, calling attention of the provisions of the corrupt practices act.

Political boomerangs may be hurled if the attention of candidates is not called to provisions of the state law which prohibit the publication and circulation of any political libelous matter," commented Mr. Evans. "The purpose of this statute was to put an end to last-minute attacks on candidates which cannot be answered before election and which usually are not based on facts."

A portion of the law reads: "If any letter, circular, poster, bill, publication or record shall contain any false statement or charges reflecting on any candidate's character, morality or integrity, the author thereof and every person printing or knowingly assisting in the circulation thereof shall be guilty of political criminal libel, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by imprisonment in the penitentiary for not less than one year nor more than three years."—Oregonian.
