SILETZ

Andrew J. Porter, engineer in direct charge of the market road work, visited Siletz, today. Monday, and looked over the condition of the road as well as the rock crusher and other machinery and he found everything in apple pie order. The old road tractor was nearly used up but now it is fixed up in first class order and it is the same with the rest of the road machinery, but it is alright now and road work has commenced in good earnest. The rock hauling will commence Wednesday and the work will be crowded right along. The late continued rain kept the roads so muddy that nothing could be done until now. There are three market roads in the county. One from Nashville to Tum Tum; one from Tum Tum to Harlan and one from Toledo to Siletz. These roads will be completed as fast as possible and when once completed will open up a large section of farm and dairy country and will accommodate a large number of people. These roads all connect with the Corvallis-Newport highway. Some \$25,000 is available to be used on these roads which is ample to finish them. This looks good. Now when the highway is finished Lincoln County will be with the outside world in fine shape. We will then be along with Coos and Tillamook Counties. "We are now between the devil and the deep sea." We cannot stop if we desire to keep up with the procession. The highway must be finished. This year we paid \$75,000 to the State—if we don't have any state roads we get none of this money back but it will be used where they have state roads and we will get none of it to be used on our roads. The hundreds of dollars we pay for license and gasoline will not be used in this county but go somewhere else in the state and we will get no benefit from it. Your correspondent, H. S. Porter of Corvallis, seems to think we ought to stop right now and see all we have already put in the road, \$140,000 and stay in the mud as we have been for the last 60 years and no one knows this better than Mr. Porter. He would turn down the line of the State—the promise to go 40-50 in the building of the road and then when it is finished, offers to take it over and keep it up and the county will have no further expense. What a fine proposition. I think we would be d—d fools if we did not accept the State's generous offer. It is strange that Mr. Porter living in the city of Corvallis, right in the midst of road building and right under the eyes of the O. A. C. where all is life animation and progress, would write such a letter as appears in last week's issue of the Leader. Already the State highway department has closed the U. S. Valley-Monroe road for the purpose of paving operations from Corvallis south a distance of eight miles on the Monroe road. A concrete project is to begin at an estimated cost of \$226,552. The cost of our part of the county's finishing the grading of the road is estimated at \$173,000. It may not take that much. This is not a large sum and only adds a few dollars to each taxpayer's amount when he pays his taxes. We expect to have and will have good roads when we get through. The increased business and population will more than offset the increased raise in taxes. Then when these roads are completed the State will take them over and keep them up. I am quite sure Lincoln County will, when the votes are counted, have a large majority for good roads and progress. Siletz I think will give three to one for good roads. If your correspondent desires to stay in the mud or go back to pioneer days when we used the Indian trails, the board shack and the canoe, he must go to somewhere else. He will never again find this condition in Lincoln County. Many of the Indians have autos and others will buy automobiles right

along. The Indian vote will go for good roads work—Mark one for them.

ARGUMENT IN FAVOR OF GOOD ROADS

May 23, 1921.

FOREWORD

The committee carrying on the publicity for this good roads campaign is meeting with some criticism for signing themselves "Your Committee" instead of using their names, let us say here and now the gentlemen composing this committee are not actuated with any personal ego and do not anticipate any glory from this movement, their whole object is to make Lincoln County a better place to live and do business. You will receive a pamphlet, thru the mails within the next week, which will give the names of those interested. The old adage "A prophet is not without honor save in his own country," might be truthfully paraphrased to read "A worker in the cause of good roads is not without appreciation save in his own community."

GOOD ROADS AND THE FARMER
One of the principle arguments being used by our friends in favor of this bond issue is "the influx of tourists, good roads will bring to our community." If this were the only object of this campaign, the writer of this article would be fighting the bond issue with all his might.

The Pioneers who first came to this wilderness, pushed forward on such roads as they then had and then on into the brush, one of their first objects after getting settled was to construct a connecting link to the outside world and each community did all in their power to help this movement with the object in view of a better, more economical and more direct means of transportation for horse drawn vehicles. The demand for good roads in those days was no more insistent than it is today, but the advent of the motor vehicle with its economical fuel cost has so widened and lengthened our supply zone, that the construction of roads has been taken out of the hands of the individual land owner and placed in the hands of the more progressive political bodies, the County, State and Nation.

One of the vital questions before the Nation today is "How to keep the young people on the farms" the most common answer given is to "Provide good roads that will reach into every hearthstone," roads that will provide happier circumstances for these young people and stop rural decay, these young folks demand more from life than a mere existence, they demand constance touch with their fellow man and community interests, good roads is the only method by which this can be attained. The energetic young man of today is not satisfied to start out with one quarter of a load, wondering whether he will be able to pull thru or not, and the road that will let a motor vehicle run along smoothly will also allow a horse drawn vehicle to take a full load, in the shortest possible time, any profitable distance.

You cannot build a house by placing the roof trusses first, you must have the foundation and uprights to rest them upon. So it is with this good road movement, we must first construct the main highway or foundation and then the market roads and laterals. The Good Roads movement is not built on a demand for means of travel for mere pleasure seekers and tourists, the demand is for roads that will carry increased tonnage, with speed in movement at the lowest possible cost in fuel and energy. Last year motor trucks hauled 1,200,000 tons of freight, this is just one half the amount hauled by railroads, and remember they were not in competition with the railroads, but hauled to what were more or less isolated communities prior to the advent of Good Roads.

Mr. Farmer there is only one way you can bring comfort to your Home, keep your children on the Farm and have horses that do not look overworked. That is by using the County State and National credit in obtaining capital with which to improve our roads as fast as we can.
