Notice is hereby given that a special election will be held in the city of Toledo on the 9th day of May, 1922, between the legal voting hours on said date as in the following resolution provided:

Thereupon the following resolution was duly offered, seconded and unanimously adopted:

RESOLUTION.

Be it resolved by the council of the city of Toledo, Lincoln county, Oregon, that the following proposed amendments to the charter of said city be and the same are hereby proposed for submission to the legal voters of said city for their adoption or rejection at a special election to be held on the 9th day of May, 1922, as herein provided, to-wit:

Charter Amendments Submitted to the Voters by the City Council.

An act to amend an act entitled "An act to incorporate the City of Toledo, Lincoln county, Oregon," filed in the office of the Secretary of State February 18, 1905, as subsequently amended by certain proposed charter amendments submitted to and adopted by the legal voters of said city at a special city election held therein on August 13, 1917, and as amended by certain proposed charter amendments submitted to and adopted by the legal voters of said city at a special city election held therein on June 24, 1919, and as subsequently amended by certain proposed charter amendments submitted to and adopted by the legal voters of said city at a special city election held therein on the 7th day of June, 1921, and to amend all other acts amending said act adopted by the legislative assembly or by vote of the people.

Be it enacted by the people of the city of Toledo that an act entitled "An act to incorporate the city of Toledo, Lincoln County, Oregon, filed in the office of the secretary of state February 18, 1905, as subsequently amended by certain proposed charter amendments submitted to and adopted by the legal voters of said city at a special city election held therein on August 13, 1917, and as amended by certain proposed charter amendments submitted to and adopted by the legal voters of said city at a special city election held therein on June 24, 1919, and as subsequently amended by certain proposed charter amendments submitted to and adopted by the legal voters of said city at a special city election held therein on the 7th day of June, 1921, and to amend all other acts amending said act adopted by the legislative assembly or by vote of the people," be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto section 80 to read as follows:

Section 80 (a) For the purpose of procuring the necessary funds to make improvements, betterments, additions and extensions to the city of Toledo water system, council of said city is hereby authorized and empowered to issue and sell negotiable coupon bonds of the city in a sum not to exceed twenty-two thousand five hundred dollars (\$22,500), said bonds to be in denominations of five hundred dollars (\$500) or one thousand dollars (\$1000) each duly signed by the Mayor and countersigned by the Recorder, whereby the city of Toledo shall be held in substance and effect to undertake and promise to pay the bearer of each of said bonds at maturity thereof the sum named therein in gold coin of the United States of the present standard of value with interest thereon in like gold coin at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum, payable semi-annually, each of said bonds to be a direct general obligation of the city of Toledo, Oregon, said bonds to be fixed at a convenient time to be fixed by the council, maturity or maturities to be likewise fixed by the council, but not to exceed twenty-five (25) years from date, and the principal and interest of said bonds shall be made payable at the fiscal agency of the state of Oregon in New York City, which said bonds shall be known as "City of Toledo Waterworks Betterment Bonds."

(b) The debt limitations contained in the charter of said city shall not apply to the bonds hereby authorized.

(c) The council shall each year at the time of making the annual tax levy for city purposes, include in such levy a sum sufficient to pay interest on the outstanding bonds of this issue, and to retire the principal thereof at maturity.

Resolved further, that this resolution for proposed charter amendments submitted to the voters by the council be filed with the recorder of the city of Toledo for submission to the legal voters of said city for their adoption or rejection, to be voted upon at a special election to be held as herein provided.

Resolved further, that the council of the city of Toledo deem it advisable and does hereby and herein call a special election to be held on the 9th day of May, 1922, at the city hall in said city between the legal voting hours on said date and at said time and place for holding said special election, and they are designated persons be and they are designated as and for the judges and clerks of said special election, to-wit: Ida Derrick and Ethel O. Ross, Judges; Albert Waugh, Edna Andrews and Anna Franklin, Clerks.

Resolved further, that for the hereinabove proposed charter amendments the following ballot title be and the same hereby is adopted by the council, to-wit:

AN ACT To amend an act entitled "An act to incorporate the city of Toledo, Lincoln county, Oregon," filed in the office of the secretary of state February 18, 1905, as subsequently amended by charter amendments submitted to and approved by the voters at special elections held August 13, 1917, June 24, 1919, and June 7, 1921, by providing for an issue of bonds not to exceed \$22,500 in amount for making additions, extensions and betterments to the water system of said city, and providing for a special tax levy to pay interest thereon and principal thereof.

SECTION 81 (a) For the purpose of procuring funds for the purchase by the City for street purposes of the following described tract of land therein, to-wit:
