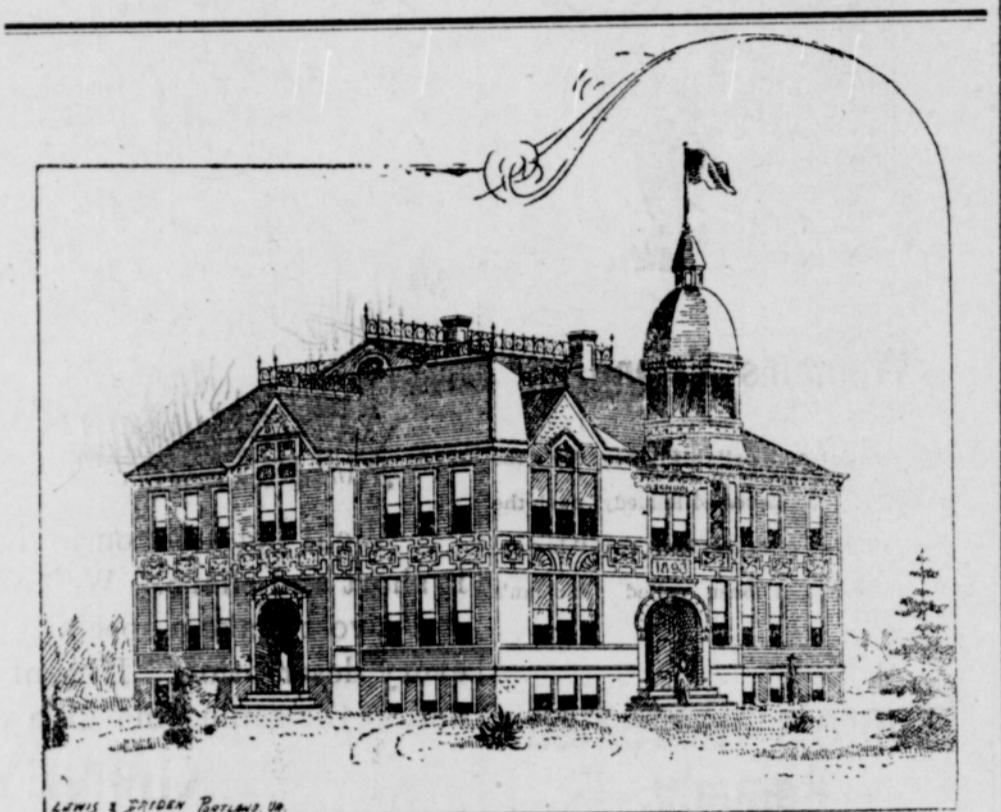

A TARIFF TALK.

U. S. Senator J. H. Mitchell Tells of the Results of the Tariff Legislation of the Recently Adjourned Democratic Congress.

U. S. Senator J. H. Mitchell in the course of a long interview printed in the Oregonian says that some of the results of the tariff legislation of the present congress. "In so far as tariff legislation in any respect is to be regarded an important factor in national and individual prosperity," said the senator, "and while the recent revision in rate by means of a legislative expression of the views of the democratic party, as enunciated in the last national democratic platform, I regard this revision as one of the most hurtful pieces of legislation ever passed on our national statute books, as affecting both national and individual prosperity.

"But, if no other objection could be properly urged against this tariff act, the fact that it strikes down our reciprocity treaties with Spain, Germany, South American republics and other countries, ought in itself to condemn it in the judgment of every right-minded American who would hesitate to subordinate American interests to those of alien foreigners, and who desire to see the trade of this country extended into those countries, which shall afford a market for our surplus products, and yet in no wise interfere with our home market.

Wants a Convention of Assessors. James A. Sterling, assessor of Douglas county, has supplied the different assessors in Oregon with copies of a circular letter the text of which is given as follows: It bears date of Sept. 10th: "My county court at this September term assumes the right to regulate the compensation of my deputies and clerks. I bid them at \$4 per day, same as mine, and the court scaled them at \$2.50 and \$3 per day.
