trol of this disease in California as well as in Oregon when applied in the fall. If we can use it in the spring also without injury, it will give us an added advantage in the control of this

Spray rigs should be put into good working condition before the season begins and kept that way. Be sure that everything is clear so that pressurse developed at the pump will not be lost in the hose or at the nozzle. See to it that a uniformly high pressure is maintained (approximately 200 pounds) throughout the opera-This is especially important for the calyx spray. For this codling moth spray use a nozzle with a 45degree angle so that the spray can be forced directly down into the calyx cups, and make frequent examinations of blossoms in least accessible places to be sure that the work is being successfully done.

Arrangements have been made for studing specifically the codling moth problem of the valley this season, and with the co-operation of the growers we hope to be able to reduce the percentage of wormy fruit to a mini-

I shall be glad to discuss specific problems of fungus or insect control with any farmer or orchardist, and co-operate with him in the solution of these problems.
