



not the fact that she is a woman farmer, doing with her own hands much of the farm work, that makes her farm worthy of attention; it is the fact that the farm itself is, first, a model of neatness and efficient management, and, second, a great success in crop production and finan-

cial profit, all of this without more than ordinary expenditure of money or labor. Getting results by spending lots of money and doing lots of work per acre is one thing (though financial profit usually does not follow that kind of farming), and getting results by good management and wise application of labor is another.


