This is to be accom- last 90 days than during all of the plished by the adoption by congress of the Liberty calendar, which is a very simple modification of the calendar now in use.

In this new calendar there are thirteen months of exactly four weeks each, every month commencing with Monday. In the construction of the calendar only three slight changes were made in the present Gregorian form. They are as fol-

First, New Year day is made an independent legal holiday. It is placed between the last day of December and the first day of January. It is not included in any week or month.

Second, another independent day, called "Correction Day," is provided for leap years. This is likewise placed between the last day of one month and the first day of the next. It is not included in any week or month.

Third, the remaining 364 days are divided into thirteen months of exactly four weeks each.

The names of the months in this new calendar are January, February, Liberty, March, etc. The use of the word "Liberty" will Americanize the calendar at the same time it is made more convenient. Under this new form all holidays and anniversaries will always fall on the same day of the week. A promissory note given for any number of weeks, months and years will always come due on the same day of the week it was given. It is claimed that the saving of time and mental effort in making calculations for future dates will be beyond all comprehension.
