An organized effort is being made
to improve the time calendar. The American Equal Month Caiendar as
sociation has been Incorporated by
50 leadling Minneapolis business and protessional men with that end view. The sole purpose of this or-
ganization is the securing of a ganization ts the securing of a
change in the calendar so that all
the months shall be of exactly the the months shall be of exactly the

In the new calendar there are
thirteen months of exactly four
weeks anthe thirteen months of exactly four
weeks each, every month commene ing with Monday. In the construention
of the calondar only three silsht of the calondar only three slight
changes were made in the present Cregorian form. They are as fol-

First, New Year day is made an
tndependent legal hollday. It is Independent legal hollday. It is
placed between the tast day of December and the first day of Janu-
ary. It is not included in any week
or month. or month.
Second,
Second, another independent day,
alled "Correction Das" called "Correction Day", is provided
for leap years. This is likewise placed Yor leap years, This is likewise placed
between the last day of one month
and the first day of the next. It is and the tirst day of the next. It is
not included in any week or month. Third, the remalning 364 days are divided into thirteen montha of exactly four weeks each.
new calendar are January, February, Liberty, March, etc. The use of the word "Liberty" will Americanize the
calendar at the same time it is calendar at the same time it is made
more convenlent. Under this now

will always fall on the same day of

beyond all comprehension.
Furtherrore, it will cause a sav-
ing of nearly fifteen million dollars a year in cost of printed and lithographed calendars, as no printed cal-
endars will be needed when this new endars will be needed when this new

the total saving of time and money
will equal fully fifty million dollars a year in this country alone. The association will alse.
