Entire Highway to be Paved this Year

Reason for laying over pavement of the Pacific highway between Monroe and Junction City is that a number of fills and changes in construction on the route remain to be made and it is the policy of the commission not to pave the same year, according to R. A. Booth, who is at his home in Eugene for a few days, says the Eugene Guard. Bids will be called for paving between Eugene and Goshen at the next meeting of the state highway commission, which comes upon May 5. Highway engineers have advised a change in the route just east of the underground crossing of the railway near Goshen. The sharp turn will be eliminated by extending the road a few yards further east before turning. The county court has agreed to buy the additional right of way necessary for the change.

At the last meeting of the legislature when decision was made to lay 15 miles of test pavement, lumbermen of the northwest guaranteed to stand the difference in cost between five miles of wood block and concrete paving. Announcement was made quite a while past that the test road would be laid between Eugene and Junction City. Final orders await for guarantees of the lumbermen. By the time this is completed the highway from the head of the Willamette valley to Portland will probably have been paved, according to Mr. Booth, who says that the intention is to have the entire stretch paved by the end of summer of next year. Mr. Booth declares that the commission has all it can do in completing the work now outlined and under way this summer.
