REASON FOR REFUSAL.

Refusal of Court to Allow Evidence of Foreign Attacks is Popular.

NEW YORK, Sept. 8.—A dispatch to the Times from Rennes, says:

There is a feeling that the foreign attaches Schwarzkoppen and Panzardi will not attend the court at Rennes and will not send a deposition. The idea of calling in a foreigner to settle Dreyfus' innocence or guilt was never popular.

It is believed that the court acted rightly in their decision. Be it remembered that they held themselves incompetent to cite the two military attaches. M. Labori goes over their heads and cite them by name. To the defendant they reply that they are unwilling to come to Rennes but are willing to give the evidence before the special commission. Had they said they would come the court would have said that they had no option but to adjourn until their arrival. But they virtually said, if you want our evidence, you must send for it, it considered that the court acted with praiseworthy dignity.

The Cernuschi fiasco will now have no result. M. Labori suggested that the state of mind of the Austrian officer be inquired into. General Mercier's attack upon Captain Freytag in the latter's absence is commented upon. Commandant Carriere, the government commissary is a rough soldier, with comical gestures. He is no orator, yet his opinion is the more valuable in consequence of the effect produced by his declaring that after one moment believing Dreyfus to be innocent, he is now convinced of his guilt. Forecasts of the character of the judgment should be received cautiously, for nothing has leaked out concerning the result of the secret sittings.

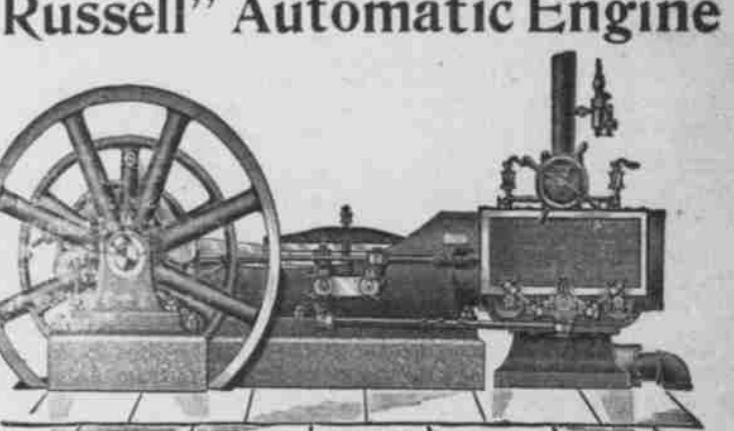
