With the enormous cheapening of tance. railway transportation, it has come to be axiomatic that the railway seeks the ultimate land.-Seattle Post-Intelligencer.



Gradually they have been gaining a hold on the transportation routes to the ultimate first-class port of Boston. Their Boston & Albany route has not been sufficient. The latest move has been to secure the Fitchburg route, which includes the former Boston, Hoosack Tunnel and Western road. Both these roads page through the famous Hoosack tunnel. by a low grade route.

The Roston, Hoosack Tunnel and Western Railway was built in 1878-81 by Boston capital. Postmaster Burt. Frederick L. Ames, and other prominent men were connected with the enterprise. For many years the New York Central antagonized this line: now the value of a port on the "ultimate land" and of a low grade route thereto is being recognized by these great capitalists.
