To His Excellency, the Governor of the State of Oregon: Hon. T. T. Geer: Dear Sir:—The Astoria Progressive Commercial Association desires hereby to tender to you its sincere thanks for your able efforts in endeavoring to induce the war department of the United States to make Fort Stevens a point of embarkation of troops for the Philippine island.

Pupils of the High School Pleased With the Columbia's Victory.

There was a patriotic smile on many an Astorian face yesterday. The bulletins announcing the progress of the yacht race were watched with interest, and the yellow paper posted in front of the Astorian office announcing the Columbia's victory caused hundreds of good citizens to feel better.

The Astorian sent the bulletins to Principal Paine of the Astoria schools, and he read them to the high school pupils. The American spirit is intense in our public schools. It finds a congenial atmosphere there, and it expresses itself upon every suitable occasion. The man of tomorrow is going to

be a truly loyal American. He inherits loyalty, he is taught loyalty, he breathes loyalty, as a boy. The ladies couldn't be also than patriotic if they tried.

And so when the news from the Astorian office was read to them, giving the welcome information that Yankee ingenuity, Yankee skill, Yankee daring and Yankee spirit had triumphed over British ingenuity, British skill, British daring and British spirit, there was a spontaneous manifestation of patriotic delight.

Men on the street may have some difference of opinion. Some may wish the Shamrock to win an account of the future of international yacht racing; some may think a victory by the Irish boat will still further cement the growing friendship between the two great Anglo-Saxon nations, but in the Astoria schools there is but one sentiment, and that is strong and eager. The boys and the girls want the Columbia to win. They want her to win every race, and they want her to win by "a very large majority."

William Wallace Thayer, ex-governor of Oregon and ex-chief justice, died at his home near Portland Sunday morning after a brief illness. He was 72 years old when he died, but was still ably attending to a large and important law practice when taken sick. In his public life he performed his full duty honestly and intelligently, and in his private and business affairs he was known as a man to be trusted and respected. His wife and an only son survive him.

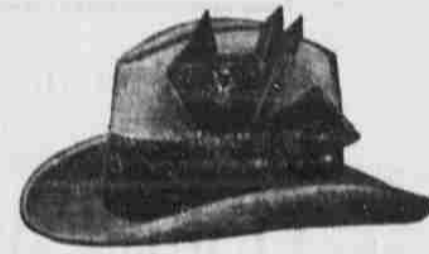
