Portland Invites The Empress City to Share Her Hospitality.

NEW TRAIN ARRANGEMENTS

New Features at the Exposition Will be Provided for the Entertainment of Astorians

Portland has formally invited Astoria to be her guest next Saturday. The exposition management has designated next Saturday as Astoria day at their big fair, and Saturday night as Astoria night.

The various heads are planning special attractions. The leader of the splendid band is arranging a special program for the visitors from the Empress city of the Columbia. There will be a big time in Portland when old Astoria turns loose there.

The mayor of Astoria, the common council, the chamber of commerce and the Push Club are to receive a special and urgent invitation. There will be a banquet for the representative bodies and all the courtesies extended that one city can show to another.

Portland flocks to Astoria regatta time. Then Astoria smiles a greeting and plays the part of hostess. Saturday she returns the call and Portland is sweeping and looking and putting on her best clothes to receive her

sister city. The Astoria & Columbia River Railroad is making arrangements for handling an immense crowd. By special terms with the Southern Pacific Company the long trains will be drawn up right into the heart of Portland, thus saving the long walk from the depot.

It is impossible to enumerate the attractions that will greet the Astorians at the exposition. The managers will have everything money and endeavor can secure. They know that Astoria will swarm next Saturday and the exposition people are very anxious that Astoria will bear home pleasing memories of their annual fair.

The admittance is practically nothing—25 cents and for children, 15 cents—and everybody is going.
