he Pacific Coast Traffic Association Actively Raising Funde With Which to Fight.

THE DIFFERENTIAL RATES

The St. Louis Traffic Bureau Has Brought Suit to Abolish the Present Rates to This Coast.

Since the organization of the Pacific coast Traffic Association by the Wholesale jobbers of Ban Francisco and other at work raising funds with which to interstate commerce commission. The suit was brought by the St. Louis Traffic bureau, and is an attempt to abolish ley will be enabled to ship in less than eye. carload lots to interior points on this coast at the same rate that carload lots are now delivered to terminal points. As the Pacific coast jobbers derive their profit from this differential by purchasing in carload lots, their business existence is threatened.

H. D. Loveland, chairman of the executive committee of the traffic association, received word yesterday from Seattle that the jobbers there are actively at work organizing and increasing in membership. There are thirty subacribers to the association there, forty at Portland and twenty at Tacoma. Each subscriber represents a contribution of at least \$50 to the fund, and in most cases much more. The least that will be contributed by the North, therefore, is \$4,500. Los Angeles is active also, and has organized an association that is in reality a branch of the one here. A big subscription is promised

from that point. The San Francisco committee has raised between \$12,000 and \$14,000 of the \$20,000 necessary. The rest will all be in, it is said, by the time it is needed. Much of the amount will go the counsel for the association. E. S. Pillsbury will probably be engaged to represent the association before the interstate commerce commission. The representatives to go from San Francisco to give testimony or to work on the case will be H. D. Loveland commision er of the Associated Wholesale Grocers of california; W. R. Whether of Holbrook, Merrill & Stetson, Charles Tay of Tay & Son, A. C. Rulofson of Baken & Hamilton, A. L. Scott of Miller, Sloss & Scott, L. Guggenheim of Mack & Company, Arthur Towne of Blake, Moffit & Towne.
