### CITY COUNCIL

The Regular Meeting Held Last Night Transacts Some Business.

The city council met in regular session last night and dispatched the business brought before it promptly.

The reading of the minutes was a prolonged ceremony for the minutes of one regular, three adjourned and one special meetings, had to be recited. Auditor Nelson suggested, with a catch in his voice, that they be termed hours. An invitation to the mayor, city council and other city officials, inviting them to attend the Portland Industrial exposition next Saturday night was read and the auditor instructed to thank the management for the courtesy and to say that as many as could make arrangements would go.

The city attorney filed an opinion relative to the bills of the News for publishing notices in connection with the Youngs bay bridge improvement. He stated that the bills could not be paid out of the general fund.

The city physician, Dr. Henderson, submitted a partial report relating the action taken in regard to the small-pox case.

### NEW OPENING IN TURKEY.

Chance for American Ingenuity to Enter That Field.

Cincinnati, O., Oct. 19.—The Enquirer says:

The publisher of a local trade paper has just received an inquiry from Smyrna, Turkey, for ready made frame houses or cottages of two stories, with veranda on the first floor, shingle roof, either painted or not, complete in every detail, excepting the window panes.

They must have from three to five rooms, not counting the servants' quarters and range in price from \$200 to \$1,000 and upwards. They must be shipped "knocked down." From 1,000 to 2,000 houses a year will be ordered.

### AGAINST LOG RAFTS.

San Francisco Will Take Steps to Prevent Any More Tonnage of That Class at Sea.

San Francisco, Oct. 19.—A committee representing the Maritime interests of this port has decided to draft a memorial to congress asking for the enactment of a law providing a penalty of \$5,000, or imprisonment for a year for constructing a log raft within the jurisdiction of the United States with the intention of having it towed to any other point in this country. The towing of the rafts on Puget sound is not included in the provision of the memorial.

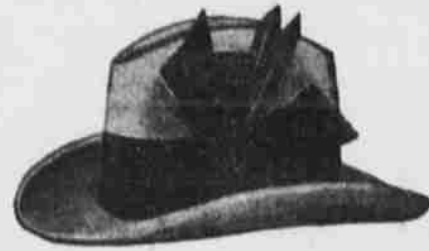
