TACOMA, Nov. 20.—Sixty tons of halibut are being loaded into refrigerator cars here for immediate transshipment to New York and other Atlantic seaboard cities.

VANCOUVER, B. C., Nov. 20.—Today's train carried to Boston and New York 75,000 pounds of halibut from the Northern Fishing grounds.

HIS PLURALITY GROWING.

Taylor Undoubtedly Elected by a Handsome Plurality, but Goebel Still Fighting.

LOUISVILLE, Nov. 20.—County board canvassers adjourned this afternoon until Wednesday after having completed official count of ballots cast Nov. 7. The city and county give Taylor a plurality of 2,413.

The work of the board today was the consideration of the contested precincts in various parts of the city which had been passed as the count progressed. Five of those were thrown out and five were counted. This resulted in a gain of two members of the legislature by the democrats.

When the county board again meets on Wednesday, it will hear argument on motion, by counsel for the democratic candidates to throw out the vote of

Jefferson county because of alleged intimidation by the state militia.

Democratic newspaper figures now give Taylor a plurality of nearly 2,000 on the state. They show that 2,400 votes are in contest and that Goebel has a plurality of 237 on uncontested votes.

NASHE'S PLURALITY.

Nearly 50,000 in Spite of the Fact That Jones Got Fully as Many Republican Votes.

COLUMBUS, Nov. 20.—Canvass of officials vote in Ohio completed this afternoon shows that Judge Nashe's plurality is 49,012. Jones, non-partisan, received 193,721 votes in the state out of a total of 308,195 votes cast. Jones drew strength about equally from the republican and democratic party.

THE PLAGUE PATIENTS.

NEW YORK, Nov. 20.—The patients removed from the steamer J. W. Taylor who are suffering from bubonic plague are recovering. Dr. Homblot said today: "I have every reason to believe that all danger of infection from those patients is past."

been devoted to discussing the probable effect of high prices on the campaign of 1906.

It is the purpose of some committeemen to organize a bureau of information and education, whose duty it shall be to gather accurate and definite information relating to trusts, cost of manufacturing, selling prices to jobbers and middlemen, selling prices to consumers, wages paid and cost of raw material.

They believe that they will be able to show that the present high prices are the result of trusts and combinations and that workmen have been given but a small proportion of the increase in selling values.

This idea has assumed such tangible form that it is predicted that W. H. (Coin) Harvey will be piced at the head of the bureau. It is proposed to employ a large staff of men to gather information which can be used in an anti-trust campaign.

There did not seem to be any disposition to shelve free silver as an issue; all committeemen said free coinage was in the platform to stay, but none of them said it would be the dominant issue.

Congressman William Sulzer, of New York, said trusts would be the issue in the next campaign.
