THE CITY ELECTION

Republicans of Astoria can elect the entire republican city ticket next Wednesday if they see fit. If the ticket is defeated or any part of it the defeat will be owing to republican apathy or republican opposition.

It may be claimed by some that a municipal election is not an important one and party lines need not be regarded. But to the men who are candidates on the republican ticket, Wednesday's election is important. No man desires defeat, even in the smallest matter, and there can be no good answer if friends of defeated candidates next June see fit to argue then in favor of the principle of independence and against too strict adhesion to party lines.

Probably fear of the candidates on the republican city ticket really desire the offices for which they are nominated. Most of them only consented to run after much earnest urging on the part of prominent party leaders. It is a sacrifice on their part and they have a right to expect earnest republican support.

Two important elections occur next year, and the republicans of that county cannot afford at this time to raise dissension and create ill-feeling in their own camp by allowing republican candidates for profitless city offices to be defeated by republican votes.

DROPPING THE CURTAIN.

A Boom That Cost Eastern Capitalists Twelve Million Dollars. Two telegrams in yesterday's Oregonian mark the close of a financial play, a money drama in real life, and in some respects a farce. The man who played the part of the hero and also, as some believe, the villain, is dead and the audacity with which he raised and dissipated twelve million dollars is past. The telegrams are as follows:

Washington, Dec. 8.—The report of the board of engineers upon the Yaquina bay investigation, made with a view to ascertaining the desirability of prosecuting the work authorized in 1894, was submitted to congress today. The board expresses the opinion that the commerce of Yaquina bay does not render it advisable to prosecute the jetty improvement, although a recommendation is made that \$30,000 be expended in removing a cluster of rocks in the channel beyond the south jetty. It deems the harbor unworthy of further improvement by the general government.

Corvallis, Or., Dec. 8.—The county court has made a contract with a Portland firm for the collection of delinquent taxes due from the Oregon Development Company. The company was one of the auxiliary organizations of the old Oregon Pacific railroad company, and it has been delinquent in tax payments to Benton county for nearly a dozen years. The total delinquency now is in the neighborhood of \$100. The company has been in the United States district court for a long time, with A. L. Maxwell as receiver since 1893. Lincoln county has a similar claim for delinquent taxes that aggregates about \$800. Among the assets of the company is a sawmill on Yaquina bay, which is now advertised for sale by the receiver.

The only real disappointment over the failure of the engineers to recommend the Yaquina improvement will be felt in the neighborhood of Yaquina bay. The people of the Willamette valley who have labored so long and faithfully to have Yaquina made a safe harbor for large vessels realized some time ago that their hope was vain, and while from custom and a sense of duty they urged the improvement against which the board of engineers has just reported they knew that the engineers would report adversely.

There was a time not long ago when the authorized million dollar contract might have been forced through, but the letting of the contract was defeated by those who should have been the first to promote it on account of the successful bidders arranging for the necessary stone with the "wrong" parties. Since then the valley people have grown very lukewarm toward the improvement.

The second telegram relates to an auxiliary of the Oregon Pacific railroad in whose construction \$12,000,000 cash was expended, not including the debts that never were paid. Mr. Hammond purchased the road for \$100,000. It is now called the Corvallis & Eastern and extends from Yaquina to the Cascade mountains.

Colonel Hogg, who engineered the scheme that ended so disastrously for its backers, is dead. One of the principal original stockholders John I. Blair, a New York millionaire, died the other day.

The road, while not realizing the dreams of its original backers, has proved of service to the people of the Willamette valley, giving them a competing line to San Francisco and an opposition boat line on the Willamette river.

It was hoped at one time that the entrance to Yaquina harbor would be so improved as to enable ships to load there with grain, thus avoiding the Portland "break-off" that operates to give the farmers low prices for their wheat. Apparently relief can no longer be looked for in that direction and the farmers will take up for themselves the proposition of obtaining common grain rates to the mouth of the Columbia river.
