The democratic policy in regard to the Philippines question for the Presidential campaign has been indicated. As soon as peace is established and a constitutional government of government is or are, inaugurated, and the said governments agree to refund the \$500,000 paid by us to the queen of Spain.

This government is also to give a ten years' protection to the governments of the island, and fight off all hostile comers. In return we are to ask a grant in fee simple of enough land for a coal station, and to have the privilege of free access to all parts of the "government of governments," and be allowed to send missionaries to Luzon.

It is a great pity, from the Filipino standpoint, that this resolution could not have been put in circulation before Aguinaldo's "government" took to the mountains. It might be difficult now to get any of the "government or governments" to stand still long enough to promise to give back that \$50,000,000 on which it is proposed we shall get out—the promise only, not the receipt.

It is a great cry and a great policy—for defeat. But there are good, loyal, sensible Americans, and not all republicans at that, who believe the work this government and the people have done in the Philippines shall not be undone by any mischievous, meddling cabal. The Philippines are ours, and ours to stay. But it is a pity any set of men calling themselves Americans should make such a spectacle of themselves as those who advocate this "throwaway" policy.
