A work of much enterprise and hard work is that of the San Francisco Chronicle's Almanac and Political Statistician for 1930. It is a paper-covered volume of nearly 500 well-printed pages, and completely covers, in encyclopedic style, every conceivable subject, particularly those of especial relation to the Pacific West. Some interesting facts are set forth in a statement made by Secretary of State Dunbar, just received at this office. In view of the state-wide controversy relative to the apportionment of state taxes for Multnomah county, it will be of interest to know that the round figures show the improvements on town lots in that county to be \$6,567,192. The value of town lots it placed at \$14,125,968; merchandise, \$2,465,745; money, \$327,225. In all the total valuation of the property of the county, after the exemptions have been made, is shown to be \$31,659,772.

Public men in Washington are said to be watching with increasing interest the situation in Kentucky. There is grave fear that the aggressiveness of the Goebel Democrat and their purpose to unseat Governor Taylor by the strength they secured in the Kentucky legislature, by means of the iniquitous Goebel election law, may result in what will approach civil war. In that case it might be necessary for the Federal government to interfere, sending troops to preserve order. The news from Kentucky is that there is serious talk of seeking an injunction from the United States circuit court, of which Judge William H. Taft is the presiding judge, to prevent the unseating of Taylor, on the ground that the fourteenth amendment to the constitution of the United States provides that "all persons born or naturalized in the United States and subject to the jurisdiction thereof are citizens of the United States and states

wherein they reside. No state shall make or enforce any law which shall abridge the privileges or immunities of citizens; nor shall any state deprive any person of life liberty or property without due process of law, nor deny to any person within its jurisdiction the equal protection of the laws." The clause which says that "no state shall deprive any person of life, liberty or property without the due process of law" is held to be the one which would refer to the Kentucky situation. It is held that office and the emoluments of the same are property rights, which must be protected, and of which a person cannot be deprived without the due process of the law. Due process of the law, it is asserted, means through the judiciary, and not by the legislature. The point made by the Taylor men is an interesting one, and Judge Taft is fair enough and impartial enough to decide the question of the injunction if it be brought before him upon the law in the case, no matter whether he helps Taylor or hurts him.
