GRADUATING EXERCISES

Splendid Program Given by High School Pupils.

Graduates Entertain Their Parents and Friends With Song and Essay.

The opera house was well filled last night at the graduating exercises of the Astoria High School. The Columbia orchestra furnished the opening music, which was followed by an oration by Wm. N. Jones on the "Chinese Question."

Mr. Jones treated very ably the anti-Chinese side of the question, and his dry humor excited the applause of the audience. He argued that the Chinese are not only filthy and breeders of disease, but so unprogressive that, were white men taking their places, Astoria would be an entirely different and by far more lively kind of a place. The general prosperity of the city would be so much heightened by the change that the council would not be obliged to compel us to spend our nights in darkness.

Mr. Jones favored sending the Chinese home, were it not for the danger of retaliation which might impair our now rapidly growing Asiatic commerce. He suggested a system of regular examination of Chinese on American soil to prevent ingress of those who have no right here, and a rigid exclusion of further Chinese immigration.

At the close of Mr. Jones' address, the orchestra again furnished music, which was followed by a charming paper by Miss Annie F. Jeffery on "Romances of the Columbia." She told very prettily the stories of Multnomah and John Rogers.

Mrs. J. T. Ross followed with a vocal solo entitled "A Dream," and responded to a hearty encore with a patriotic selection.

The next paper was by Miss Jessie Sanis, and entitled, "On the Mountain Heights." She said energy alone was necessary to mount from the base, where the young graduates stand, to the summit of attainment, citing the lives of Lincoln and Blaine as examples of what might be accomplished by untiring endeavor. She argued that greatness was equally possible to women, as evidenced in the life of Joan of Arc.

After another selection by the orchestra, Miss Reba Hobson favored the audience with a solo entitled "Cherette," which elicited great applause.

The valedictory was then delivered by Miss Edith L. Wood, who chose as her subject, "Drops of Gold." She said that the strife for gold which is easily lost, was one of the commonest things in life, but how few strive for a good character, that pearl of great price. Again, as the miser treasures up his little pellets of gold, so we treasure up the memories of the good deeds we have known and kindnesses tendered us by those with whom we have mingled in our school days. When the gold is found mixed with mire or gravel the miser separates them and throws the refuse away. How foolish we would think him if he should cast away the gold and retain the sand! So let us not throw away pleasant memories and retain thoughts of unpleasant words and deeds. She then turned to the board of education, thanking them for the mental uplift the class had received through the training the board had made possible. Then, turning to the teachers, she very gracefully thanked them for their kindly efforts in behalf of the class. Turning finally to the class, she urged it to improve the advantages gained and make the most of life.

After another selection by the orchestra, Pres. W. H. Lee, of Albany College, was introduced. He said in part:

"Education is the most important element of our national greatness. Athens put her ideas into marble. America puts her ideas into men. Upon the intelligence of the American people rests the greatest democracy the world has ever known."

It is a common thing to look at an education as we would at a piece of dry goods. We ask, "what does it cost?" It costs money, time, labor and self-sacrifice; less of money than any of the rest. My college education cost me \$1000, but one can be had in Oregon for half that. It costs sixteen or more years of time. It costs hard, persevering work. Some get it more easily than others, but they get less out of it. Education must be obtained at the cost of other things, such as social engagements, for instance.

What is it good for? An education stands in proportion to a lack of education as 50 to 1, to ensuring success in life. America has had in all its history about 200,000 college graduates. In this time there have lived here 100,000,000 men. Fifty-eight per cent of professional positions have been held by college graduates, so that one-fifth of one per cent of the men have produced nearly six-tenths of the men holding the best positions. In business 38 per cent of the positions are held by college men.

"From the standpoint of cash a college education pays. An uneducated man earns perhaps \$2 per day for 300 days in the year, working 40 years; making his total earnings \$24,000. The college man has a salary of \$500, and in 40 years earns \$40,000; so on the sordid basis of cash his education, on an average, would be worth the difference, or \$16,000. Education makes promotion possible. I congratulate the citizens of Astoria on the evidence we have had tonight of the character of your high school, and applaud the public spirit of the people who support such an institution."
