LONDON, Aug. 11.—Andrew Carnegie sends to the Associated Press the following statement regarding the situation in the far East and the relation of the United States to further developments there.

"The refusal of the United States to participate in the attack on the Taku forts makes the Washington government the natural mediator between China and the European powers, but America's position may be easily forfeited by agreeing to join their action.

"Great Britain is going to land troops to protect Shanghai because she looks upon the Yangtze Valley as her special province. Russia keeps her chief forces in Manchuria. France is in another region and Germany is in a fourth.
