

CHANGE IS DECIDED ON

DEMOCRATIC REPRESENTATION ALTERED.

Senator to Be Nominated With State Ticket and Voted Upon Next June.

PORTLAND, Jan. 30.—At a meeting of the Democratic state central committee today it was decided to re-appoint the representation in the state convention upon the basis of one delegate for each 125 votes and major fraction thereof cast for T. G. Green, Democratic nominee for supreme court judge in 1900.

A resolution was also adopted urging the state convention to nominate a candidate for United States senator to be voted for at the next June election with other candidates on the state ticket.

The date for holding the state convention and also the place of meeting was not decided, the chairman being authorized to fix the time and place.

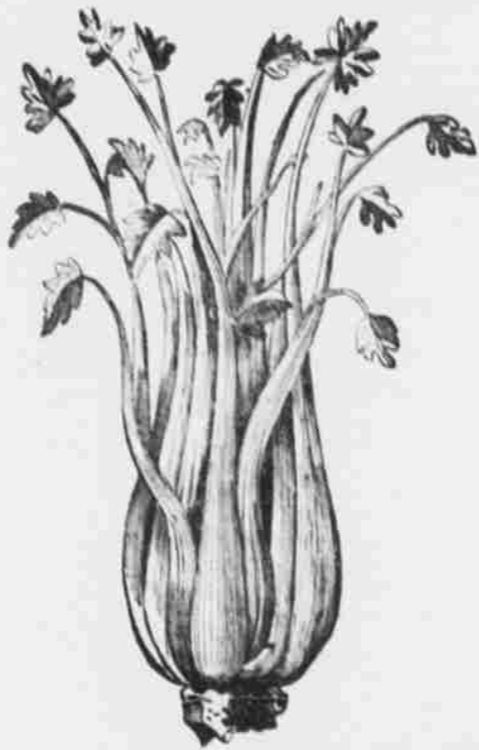
