COAST SALMON PACK.

The following revised statement of the 1901 salmon pack for the Pacific Coast is from the Seattle Trade Register:

Table with 2 columns: Districts—Cases. Puget Sound 1,410,144; Washington Coast 60,916; Columbia River, Washington side 114,370; Columbia River, Oregon side 126,400; Oregon Coast 69,549; Alaska 2,022,704; Fraser River, B. C. 246,879; B. C., northern rivers 256,826; California rivers 17,500.

Compared with the 1900 pack, Alaska shows an increase in its record pack last season of 424,368 cases. Puget Sound shows an increase in its record pack of 904,157 cases over 1900, the greatest previous pack being 582,324 cases in 1899.

As for the barreled salmon, it is almost impossible to gain anything like a probable statement of the output. The arrivals for last season at San Francisco from Alaska were 15,214 barrels, and possibly 5000 barrels handled at Seattle, making a total of 23,214 barrels for 1901 against a total of 27,533 barrels for the coast in 1900.

While the pack has been phenomenally large, there has been an unusual amount of poor fish packed, some of which found its way to New York and a large amount to England. This
