The manufacturers of the country are now importing more than a milion dollars' worth of material for their workshops every day in the year, and are exporting more than a million dollars' worth of their finished product each day. The imports of nanufacturers' materials in the eight onths ending with February, 1902, were, according to a statement just ssued by the treasury bureau of statistics, \$270,202,774 and the exports of finished manufactures during the same period were \$257,907,430. 
