certain candidate is about to withdraw from the race, and a thousand other campaign stunts.

"From the statement of one man, whether he has any foundation for making the statement or not in a few hours' time he may ruin the prospects of a candidate, or do him great damage, and in this same way character is blasted.

The country town is a great place for the manufacture of rumors but the small city is probably the greatest. It is easier to trace the origin of a rumor in a small town than in a small city. In a large city the rumor-maker stands no show except among his intimate circle, and people there have not the time to listen to them. But in the small cities a rumor is easily started, the origin easily concealed and the damage great.

"Campaign rumors will begin to materialize as election day approaches and it would be well to demand of the one giving startling news where he learned it and not to aid him in spreading it.

"A fair vote of the people with the truth before them is all that the Republicans desire."
