

TO BUILD BATTLESHIP

NEW YORK NAVY YARD IS AWARDED CONTRACT.

Fully 1000 Men to Be Employed—All Departments Are in First-Class Shape.

NEW YORK July 8.—Rear-Admiral Barker, commandant, and the heads of the departments at the New York navy yard are happy over the navy department's decision to have a warship built there.

It is estimated that 1000 men will be employed on the ship when she is fully under way and many former employees of the yard who are experienced workmen will be taken on again.

PIERPONT ARRIVES IN GERMANY Is Quickly Recognized—Speaks Well of the Kaiser.

NEW YORK, July 8.—J. Pierpont Morgan's arrival here caused a great stir, cables the Berlin correspondent of the Herald.

At one of the news stands Mr. Morgan lingered long enough to see a cartoon of himself in Lustige Blätter, showing him lying at full length over a map of America and stretching out his hands to England and Germany.

Asked about his meeting with the Kaiser, Mr. Morgan said: "I am very sorry, but I cannot say anything about the Kaiser. He was exceedingly courteous to us. He is a great man for fact."

Clement A. Griscom, who was with the party on board the Meteor, said: "The Anglo-Saxon countries, the United States, Great Britain and Germany are destined to rule the sea and commerce. Germany is a growing nation. The Kaiser is fully acquainted with the relations between the trans-Atlantic shipping company which Mr. Morgan has formed and the German steamship companies."
