

WILLEMSTAD, Curacao, July 14 .-Advices received here from Venezueh say that 900 revolutionists under General Penaloza are approaching Puerto Cabello (a city of the state of Carbobo Venezuela) and that 400 men from the local bands are now concentrated near El Palito. The Venezuela government has fortified and entrenched Puerto Cabello. An attack on that place by the revolutionists is expected shortly. If this occurs the city will be shelled.
