THE PROPOSED CUBAN LOAN.

That is happening which was expected to happen. The government of Cuba finds itself in such financial straits that it proposes to incur a debt much greater than the ordinary revenues of Cuba shall provide for.

A reduction in the American duties of Cuban products has been urged as a kind of obligation resting upon the United States as compensation for the incorporation of the Platt amendment into the Cuban constitution.

Without doubt one purpose of the Platt amendment was to put it out of the power of the Cuban government to incur a large debt to pension Cuban soldiers who had taken part in the war against Spain.

According to figures compiled by the Chicago Livestock Journal, there was a decrease of \$1,555,795 pounds of beef, live weight, marketed in July, 1902, as compared with July, 1901.

In the corresponding period of 1901 were marketed at these points in the first seven months of 1902.
