NEW YORK, Oct. 23 .- Official announcement has been made, according in 1903. to the World, that a controlling interest of the St. Joseph & Grand Island railroad has been purchased by the Union Pacific and allied interests to prevent the Rock Island from obtainthe open market.

The line, while not big, is important, strategically, to trunk lines, especially valuable to the Union Pacific. It runs from St. Joseph, Mo., to Grand Island, Neb., 259 miles, and has trackage from St. Joseph to Kansas City, 61 miles.
