MOST SPECTACULAR FIRE

EVER WITNESSED IN NEW YORK -LOSS OVER HALF MILLION -RAGED 35 FEET HIGH.

NEW YORK, Nov. 10.-The new East river bridge was damaged to the amount of half a million dollars tonight by a fire that raged 35 feet in the air on the summit of a great steel tower on the New York side.

It was necessary to stop all traffic up and down the river. The fire was the most spectacular conflagration ever seen in New York. It started in a tool shed. The Brooklyn fire boat was just below the bridge and a heavy beam fell on her, breaking the rudder and sending her drifting down stream.

It was 1 o'clock before the flames had devoured everything combustible, leaving only the steel tower and four great 18 1/2 steel cables stretching across the river. It is feared the cables have been badly damaged by the intense heat.

FAULT OF LEADERS

Pilgrimage of Fanatics Alleged to Be a Blind.

WINNIPEG, Man., Nov. 10.-The Doukhobors were unloaded this morning at Yorktown and started for their villages which should be reached tomorrow night.

"Sometime ago, he said, 'the government warned the Doukhobors that if they did not homestead their farms, the land would be thrown open for settlement. The leaders have been attempting to force the hands of the government by inducing their countrymen to make a pilgrimage under a pretense of looking for Jesus.'

GREAT LOSS OF LIFE. More Serious Than At First Reported -Over Sixty Missing.

MELBOURNE, Nov. 10.-The British steamer Elangamite has been wrecked on the coast of Three Kings island. Forty-one were saved Monday and six are still missing.

The steamer carried 110 passengers. Steamers have been sent to search for rafts and the boats. Lloyd's reports 37 passengers saved and it is feared the remainder have been lost.

FOR THE SPEAKERSHIP

Congressman Cannon of Illinois Likely to Succeed Henderson.

CHICAGO, Nov. 10.-A majority of the Illinois delegation to congress gathered here today and endorsed Congressman Cannon for speaker in the house of representatives.

VICTIM OF BICYCLE ACCIDENT

After Six Months in Plaster Cast Minister Recovers.

NEW YORK, Nov. 10.-After having been encased for six months in a plaster cast, which covered his entire body except his head and the lower parts of his legs, the Rev. Horace Porter, victim of a bicycle accident, has returned to Plymouth church, where he

is assistant to Dr. Newell Dwight Hillis. The accident, which occurred in 1900, caused the drawing up of Mr. Porter's limbs so that he was unable to stand, an extraordinary operation, the cutting of several important ligaments, was performed and the pastor, after six months in a plaster cast, is now able to walk with crutches. These probably will be discarded shortly.

DR. WISE IN NEW YORK

PORTLAND RABBI DELIVERS A STRONG ADDRESS ON "POLITICAL CORRUPTION."

NEW YORK, Nov. 10.-"Political corruption," he said, "is the spirit of blind, bigoted partisanship. Men think today that parties are ends in themselves. They are only means to the end which is the end which is the country's good."

"Political corruption, could not last an hour if the so-called respectable classes did not tolerate and support it. Let us have an end to this Irish-American, German-American, or Zulu-American. We are all Americans. I am an American. In my religion and moral teachings I am a Jew, but I would not vote for a Jew unless he was three times as good as his opponent, for fear that he might discredit that religion."

Headlessness of Americans Render Conditions Anarchistic.

CHICAGO, Nov. 10.-Conditions almost anarchistic prevail in the United States according to John H. White, Episcopal bishop of Northern Indiana. In a sermon at Grace church yesterday he declared that the American people had forgotten their duties in a mad rush for wealth and fame.

IMPROVEMENTS TO BE MADE ON FRESH WATER HARBOR

Appropriations Made for the Purpose—Whiskey Dug Up From the Earth.

EVERETT, Wash., Nov. 10.—Work is to be renewed at once on Everett's fresh water harbor. There is an appropriation of \$117,000 on hand which will carry operations eight months. At the end of this time the government will have spent her \$400,000 as originally planned, although \$117,000 more will be asked for.
