POSTAL RECEIPTS FOR OCTOBER.

Statistics Show an Increase of 13 Percent Over a Year Ago.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 11.-Statistics of the gross postal receipts of the government for last month, as compared with October 1901, at 50 of the largest postoffices in the country, show a total of \$5,580,599, an increase of 13 percent. The largest 'acrease was 36 percent at Los Angelas, while the largest decrease was 11 percent at Buffalo.

This is the second jail delivery i a month and a new prison is being cut out of the side of the mountain where escape will be well nigh impos sible.




