ographer bearing a telegram from President Castro to the commandant of San Carlos, landed on the island and entered the fort. The walls of the fort are terribly hammered and show many evidences of the firing.

The village of San Carlos suffered greatly. The aim of the German gunners appeared to have been inaccurate for more than 50 percent of the shells exploded in the village before reaching the fort.

General Bello, commander of the fort, is a soldier of remarkable courage and daring. He will not abandon the fort, but will resist as long as it is possible for him to do so.

DISTASTEFUL TO US.

Administration Regards Bombardment of San Carlos as Incomprehensible.

Washington, Jan. 22.—The continued bombardment of Fort San Carlos by the Germans seems quite incomprehensible to the officials of the administration in Washington.

The bombardment has created a decidedly unfavorable impression here and a feeling of genuine regret at a time when negotiations looking to a settlement of the difficulties between Venezuela and her European claimants seemed almost under way.

ITALIANS DON'T LIKE IT.

Rome, Jan. 22.—The second bombardment yesterday of Fort San Carlos by German warships has produced an unfavorable impression here, as the necessity for violence is considered to have passed.

Chicago, Jan. 22.—A salary increase amounting to an aggregate of nearly half a million dollars a year was granted to the teaching force of the Chicago public schools by the board of education last night.

ELIOT ON UNIONS.

Misguided Educator Blindly Insists That a Scab Is a Hero.

Buffalo, N. Y., Jan. 22.—President Eliot of Harvard university addressed 1500 high school pupils yesterday and in the course of his remarks said: "In 1894 I took occasion to say in a public speech that a 'scab' is a hero, and I still see nothing wrong in that remark. I have been a believer in labor unions, but my remark angered one man high in the councils of unionism and he wrote a letter condoning with me on my ignorance and wading up with what he called a curse. It was: 'I wish that you may live long, have hard work, long hours and a hungering stomach while you live.'

PETITIONS FOR REDRESS.

Bunco Artist Jumped His Bail and Plaintiff Wants Satisfaction.

Boston, Jan. 22.—One of the most unique petitions ever laid before the Massachusetts legislature has been introduced in the house by Daniel Leonard of Agawam, who asks that the county of Hampden reimburse him for the loss of \$4000 which he claims he lost through a bunco game to Frank Smith. Leonard claims that after Smith obtained the money from him on April 7, 1900, he reported the facts to the authorities and Smith was finally arrested, indicted and bailed for \$5000. Smith then jumped his bail and the money was then paid into the Hampden county treasury. A part of the sum, Leonard believes, should be paid back to him for his efforts in making the arrest of Smith.

ANOTHER NEGRO APPOINTED.

Opposition Develops to Roosevelt's Choice for Collector at Charleston.

Washington, Jan. 22.—The nomination of Dr. W. D. Crumm, a colored man, to be collector of port at Charleston, S. C., was the subject of an hour's hearing today by the senate committee on commerce, before which the nomination is pending.

Senator Tillman and others, in opposing Crumm's nomination, charged that Crumm's color, and Senator Tillman ad the Minnesota republican convention. It was made quite plain, however, that the principal opposition was because of Crumm's color, and Senator Tillman admitted as much.

VERDICT AGAINST SHARKEY.

Pupilist Violated Liquor Law and Must Forfeit Bond.

New York, Jan. 22.—P. W. Cullinan, state commissioner of excise, has obtained a verdict from Judge Blanchard, in the supreme court, for \$1500, the amount of bonds furnished by a fidelity and deposit company on behalf of Thomas Sharkey, the pupilist, and Bernard Reich, when they obtained a liquor license in this city. The bond is given in such cases to provide against violations of the law during the existence of the license, and the excise commissioner took proceedings to recover the amount of the bond because of violations of the law in February last.

STUDENT SUES.

Lost His Eyesight in College and Now Wants Damages.

CHICAGO, Jan. 22.—Smith Parks, a former student of the dental school of Northwestern university, has brought suit against the university for \$30,000 damages for the loss of an eye. Parks recites in his bill that in 1901 he was a student at the university, and that while he was making an experiment with hydrogen gas the tube connected with a burner exploded. The flying gas lodged in his eye and caused him to lose the sight.

ORANGES BY CARLOAD.

Los Angeles, Jan. 22.—Railroad officials say that there will be between 22,000 and 23,000 carloads of oranges shipped from southern California this year and that the fruit is the best ever grown here. It promises to be the banner year, as the most perfect fruit which ever left the state is going out now, and the highest prices ever offered for oranges are being paid in the east. Unless some unforeseen disaster comes it is safe to calculate that at least \$15,000,000 will be put into circulation in southern California.

FIRST WARSHIP IN HAVANA.

New York, Jan. 22.—The French cruiser Tage has arrived from Martinique, via Santiago, says a dispatch from Havana to the Tribune. She is the first warship to enter the Havana harbor since the inauguration of the Cuban government last May. Rear-Admiral Rivet, commander-in-chief of the second division of the Atlantic, is on board the Tage.

IRON WORKER DEAD. J. W. Clute Was a Member of the Firm That Built the Monitor.

Schenectady, N. Y., Jan. 22.—Jethro W. Clute is dead at his home in this city, aged 70. For many years he was a member of the firm of Peter L. Clute & Sons, who operated an iron foundry here for over half a century. During the Civil war the engine and boilers of the "Monitor" were built at this foundry, of which Mr. Clute was then proprietor. He retired from business 20 years ago, devoting his time to caring for his large fortune. He is survived by a wife and four children.
