IMMIGRATION FIGURES.

The immigration figures for the calendar year 1902 show the arrival of over 90,000 immigrants during the 12 months that were reported for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1902.

An examination of the record in detail shows, out of 738,289 immigrants in the United States last year, 702,288 were from Europe, 28,767 from Asia, and 5,267 from the West Indies.

The swarm of immigrants entering this country from eastern and southern Europe is causing not a little apprehension. The influx of more than half a million of these foreigners per year, if long continued, would undoubtedly raise some serious problems...

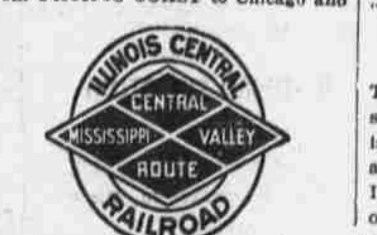
