MOODY DOES GOOD WORK.

Representative Moody is further endearing himself to his constituency by his gratuitious efforts in Washington in behalf of Indian war veterans. Notwithstanding his term of office expired a month ago he has been diligently taking up the matter with the war and pension departments and has sucresided in finding out why many deserving claims have been disallowed in the past and in providing a means of securing for worthy men and their heirs what the government intended for them. It seems that, in the absence of records showing the enlistement of certain men, the law provides that the record of pay is sufficient evidence of enlistment and service. As the pay allowed was only \$11 per month, many of the men did not demand it and their records are consequently incom plete, which accounts for their pension claims being disallowed, while the reward congress intended for them is still in the treasury.

Mr. Moody is now sending out blank applictions, which will secure for the veterans the arrearages due them and establish their right to pensions. This is noble service.

Eighteen months ago the London county council appointed a committee to inquire into the causes of London fogs.
