Fish Warden's Monthly Report

Statement Of Master Fish Warden Of Business Of His Office During May.

The report of Master Fish Warden Van Dusen for the month of May states the business of his office as follows: On May 1, W. I. Reed, as manager for the Rainier Mill & Lumber company plead guilty and was fined \$50 and costs in the justice court in Rainier on the charge of allowing sawdust from the mill to enter the waters of the Columbia.

At the Salmon river hatchery 354,000 steelhead salmon eggs were taken during the last two months for spawning purposes, and the superintendent is now preparing the necessary racks for taking chinook salmon.

"We are anxious to do work with the blueback salmon at this station and are in hopes that he will be able to get in our main stop rack across the river in time to stop the few bluebacks that may be on their way to the Wallowa lake for spawning purposes."

"A few years ago there were several thousand of this variety of salmon at this point annually from which a great many million eggs could have been taken, but now, after the deadly work that has been done on this upper stream by the irrigating ditches it is very questionable. We are in hopes that there are a few left and that with this few we will be able to get a start and in time build up the product and make the blueback as numerous as they were before the day of the ditches."

Also on the subject of the new hatchery station at Ontario: "At the Ontario station I have finally succeeded in getting a description of the land we desire for hatchery purposes and I beg to submit herewith for your approval and acceptance the deed duly executed by Mr. and Mrs. J. D. Billingsley conveying the property to the state of Oregon in accordance therewith; the same comprising 19.97 acres more or less."
