Astoria's Opportunity

ASTORIA will soon have an opportunity to show her neighbors and friends just what she can do in the way of entertaining, and of what she is capable of providing in those things that come under the category of "a good time."

Upon every individual in the city rests a duty and responsibility. It is a simple duty and plain responsibility, to-wit: the duty of upholding the enviable reputation of the city, as the most hospitable place in the state of Oregon, and the responsibility of making the carnival an instantaneous success by according its management liberal local patronage in its efforts to eclipse previous regattas in the amount of pleasure and entertainment of its friends and guests.

The success of the smallest undertaking of this kind depends entirely on the support of the whole community. The committee in charge of the arrangements can only do the executive work. It is up to the people to constitute themselves a committee of the whole to rush the regatta to a successful issue.

All business men in the city without exception will receive financial returns from the regatta, and it therefore behooves the business men to make special efforts to enhance the brilliancy of the event. This they can do in a thousand different ways. Every square inch of the public thoroughfares should be gay with bunting; the stars and stripes should wave from every flagstaff in the city; the business houses should be appropriately represented in the great industrial, commercial and civil parade, and special attentions should be paid to the visitors, who will assemble from all parts of this and adjoining states.

Particularly in the matter of decorations should the merchants and citizens generally be generous; the expenditure of a few dollars in festoons of bright colors will go a long way towards the success of the regatta, and will do more than anything in outward show to make the visitors feel that Astoria is indeed entitled to that picturesque term, "The Venice of America."

Let all units from no won to make the regatta the grand success that it deserves to be.
