The entire matter was, on Patterson's motion, referred to the committre on judiciary, and the senate took up and passed the house bill for the eradication of the cotton boll weevil. The resolutions looking to an investimation of the affairs of the postoffice department were laid before the senate, but by unanimous consent went over again until tomorrow.

Hale offered the following resolution as the result of an agreement between himself and Bacon during yesterday's mansion, looking to a settlement of the Panama question:

"Whereas, The state of Panama, formerly part of the Republic of Colombia, has seceded from that republic and has set up a government, republican in form, and under the name of the Republic of Panama; and

"Whereas, The Independence of said Republic of Panama has been recogniaed by the United States and by many other nations; and

"Whereas, A treaty is now pending before the senate between the United States and the Republic of Panama, and the ratification of which will insure the speedy building of the interoceanic canal by the United States across the territory of said Republic of Panama; therefore,

"Resolved, that in any claim in which the republic of Colombia in any form may make against the republic of Panama for indemnification or loss of territory or increased burden of the said republic of Colombia the president is requested to tender his best offices toward the peaceful adjustment of all controversies arising or that may arise betwen said republic of Colombia nad the republic of Panama."

Trespass Bill introduced.

The resolution was read and Hale of the court." stated that he presented it as a substitute for the Bacon resolution. He forced. said he would not ask for immediate consideration.

The Panama resolution, offered by Gorman, was laid before the senate. and Mr. Carmack was recognized. He said the republican administration had been guilty of the worst kind of parti-Spooner law because of the fear that the opposition would secure an advantage.

Cattleman is Dead.

San Francisco, Jan. 13 .- J. R. Wilkins, a well known cattleman of Idaho and father of Miss Kittle C. Wilkins the "Idaho Horse Queen," has just died here. He was a native of Indiana 73 years old, and came across the plains to this coast in 1853.

TO THE PUBLIC. The attention of the public is called to the following rules and regulations

of the state board of health: Rule 15-No person shall be admitted into any school or Sunday school tron any house or building in which has recently occurred a case of dangerous communicable disease, without first presenting a certificate, signed by a reputable physician, that all danger of comunicating such disease is past.

Rule 16-N parent, guardian, or other person having charge or control of any child or children shall allow or permit any child or children to go from any house or building in which a case of smallpox. diphtherin, membraneous croup, scarlet fever, measles, whooping cough, or other contagious disease has recently occurred antil such house or building has been properly disinfected, and guarantine has been removed by the health officer.

Rule 17-It shall be the duty of every physician called to attend a person sick, or suspected of being sick, or in the absence of a physician, every householder, wherein such sickness is found, too report within 34 hours thereafter, giving the name and residence of all cases of smallpox, diphtheria, membrineus croup, scarlet fever, measles, or any other contagious disease, to the county health officer, or other health officer who has jurisdiction in the territory

Rule 18-(in part)-It shall be the duty of the health officer, when a case of smallpox, yellow fever, diphtheria, membraneous croup, scarlet fever or measles is reported within its jurisdiction, to place, or cause to be placed. in a conspicious place a quarantine card upon which is printed in large letters the name of the disease or the word "contagious."

Section 10 of the state board of health laws is as follows:


"Any person who shall fail to obey or shall violate such order, shall, on conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$100, at the discretion






