# **EXECUTIONS**

Corean Courts Anxious to Clean Out Prisons, So Inmates Are Put to Death.

DECAPITATED AND HANGED

Emptied Cells Are at Once Refilled With Bound Prisoners to Wait Their Turns With the Executioner.

New York, March 21 .- Numerous executions at the local prison are reported to be due to the movement of the supreme court in the direction of clearing out the place, says a Seoul dispatch to the Herald. The total in three nights past has been six prisoners decapitated and 38 hanged. Many of these victims had been in jail for years without trial,

Some were former students in Japan and others were thieves, highwaymen, embezziers of public funds, political offenders and traitors. As the bodies are carried out strings of 10 or 20 condemned men bound together refill the cells just vacated,

It is probable the representatives of the foreign powers will investigate and if justified, take action. The prison is heavily guarded, as it is feared the pediars guild may attempt to force an entrince, and liberate the prisoners.
