## SAW CRIMINALS BEFORE HER

Mrs. Ballington Booth Startles Fashionable Congregation in New York.

### SAID THEY SAT IN THE PEWS

Members of the Congregation Looked at Each Other to Detect Her Possible Meaning.

New York, June 13.—In an address at the Madison avenue reform church, Mrs. Ballington Booth has caused much consternation among the members of the fashionable congregation. She was speaking of the work in the state prisons of the country and the success in the reformation of so-called "habitual" criminals.

"I see before me many examples of what the love of Jesus Christ can do for habitual criminals," she said. "I see here former convicts with their wives and some even with children."

Many of the listeners looked at one another as if each felt that a neighbor might be one of those to whom Mrs. Booth was referring. Suspicious glances were cast and many looked askance to see a tell tale blush, but none was observable and Mrs. Booth continued her remarks, assuring the congregation that she did not intend going into details.
