GAVE HIM THE SLIP

Reggie Vanderbilt Turns the Tables on the Detectives Who Tried to Catch Him.

WAS NOT IN NEW YORK

While Detectives Were Surrounding House He Was on Train on His Way to Boston.

New York, June 14.—Subpoena servers from the district attorney's office, who attracted much attention laying siege to the Nelson residence in Fifth avenue from Friday night until Sunday in the hope of serving papers on Reginald Vanderbilt (as they have sought to do for several months) ordering him to appear as a witness in the Richard Canfield case, have been vindicated, according to the Herald. It is now learned that Mr. Vanderbilt did not hoodwink the detectives because he was not in the city much less within the home of his mother-in-law.

Returning from the Philadelphia horse show he is understood to have been met at Jersey City by a tug which carried him around Manhattan to Greenwich, Conn., where he took a train for Boston.

Pearls Still Expensive.

Although the pearl fishery season in Ceylon has been a record one, the government earnings having amounted to over £1,000,000 (\$5,000,000), there is no prospect of a fall in the price of pearl necklaces.

"Ceylon pearls," said a member of the firm of E. Hahn & Co., of Hatten Garden, London, recently, "will not affect the British market. The bulk of the pearls we get come from western Australia. Prices are high, and a 10-grain pearl will continue to bring £200 (\$1000) for some time to come."

Mr. Streeter of the well-known Bond street firm remarked that Ceylon pearls are never larger than a pea—three or four grains at the most. "Even a record yield," he said, "would not bring about a fall in the English market price."

TWO GIRLS DROWNED.

Went Fishing Near Pomeroy and Both Lost Their Lives.

Pomeroy, Wash., June 14.—Bertha Parker and Mabel Dinkins, two young women, aged about 20 years, were drowned this morning in a backwater slough on the Schneekloth place, on Snake river, at the mouth of Deadman creek. The girls arose early before the Schneekloth family were up and went fishing in a skiff. There was no eyewitness to the accident.

It appears in attempting to land the boat slid out from under them as they tried to step out. Both bodies were recovered about two hours afterward by Jack Carmiere and Gus and Jim Schneekloth, who dragged the slough. The two girls were visiting at the Schneekloth ranch. Miss Dinkins was soon to have married Emil Schneekloth. She was related to former Sheriff Gilbert Dinkins, of this county. Miss Parker was the daughter of former Representative James Parker, of Mayview, this county.

Miss Dinkins was the daughter of C. F. Dinkins, of Chewelah, Wash., who was telegraphed of his daughter's death, and who will arrive in Pomeroy tomorrow to take her body to Chewelah.
