NOTED DIVINE IS DEAD.

Rev. Samuel Moss, Prominent in Baptist Educational Circles.

New York, July 13.—The Rev. Dr. Samuel Moss, one of the foremost Baptist educators and divines, is dead at his home here after an illness of more than a year. He was born in Kentucky 75 years ago. Dr. Moss served as president of the old Chicago university and of the Indiana State university at Bloomington. He was also editor of several Baptist publications. For the last three years he made his home in this city.

WAS NOT MURDERED.

Suspicious Knife Marks on Woman's Throat Made by Surgeon.

New York, July 13.—Investigation has dissipated most of the mystery surrounding the death of a young woman found Monday night in the hallway of a flat building in East Twenty-ninth street. She was at first supposed to have been murdered because of knife wounds in the throat which appeared to have severed the jugular vein.

It has transpired that the cuts were made by a surgeon in performing an operation several days ago, and that the woman died from natural cause. She has been identified as a character of the streets.
