Physicians for Panama.

It is expected that 25 of the 300 physicians the government is preparing to send to the Isthmus of Panama will be chosen from civil life in Philadelphia. This statement was made by an officer at the League Island navy yard recently. He said that the bulk of the physicians would be selected from Washington, New York and Philadelphia. This statement was made by men engaged on the isthmus, it is believed that 300 physicians will be none too many to look after their health. The higher positions will be allotted to the government surgeons. Young and active physicians are needed, tough, hard, hardy fellows, who are not afraid to rough it. There will be a preference shown to those who just graduated from the hospitals. Colonel Gorgas, the chief sanitary officer of the isthmus, will send out the call for the physicians.—American Medicine.
