MINISTER IS SUSPECTED

Rev. Leland immediately started by the first train to Pueblo to attend the annual Methodist conference. A message from Pueblo states that he has been received most cordially by all the brethren at the conference.

It was at Rev. Mr. Leland's house that two men, resisting intrusion, shot several times at Sheriff Bell and deputies.

to surrender the Mexican dollars and the Spanish coin with which they had been familiar for so many years in favor of the new Philippine peso proposed by the commission. But reports received here show that the change had been made smoothly and more expeditiously than was thought possible. Colonel Edwards, chief of the insular bureau, has just received the following letter from Henry C. Ide, secretary of finance and justice of the Philippines, dated Manila, July 22, bearing on this subject:

"You will be interested in knowing our currency scheme has made progress since I last wrote you. All the business houses have by common consent put their business on the basis of the new currency. In all the provinces it is found in free circulation and the people now object strenuously to taking any other currency. The old currency has been very largely brought into the insular treasury for re-coining."
