BREAKFAST: Cracked Wheat, Tenderloin Steak, Rolls, Baked Potatoes, Coffee.
DINNER: Cream of Pea Soup, Boiled Potatoes, Potato Balls, Fried Eggplant, Tomato Salad, Fruit Pudding, Coffee.
SUPPER: Boudins, Creamed Potatoes, Rolls, Chocolate Layer Cake, Tea.
BOUDINS:—One pint cold chopped meat, one tablespoon chopped parsley, also one of butter, one-half cup stock or milk, two tablespoons fine bread crumbs; salt and pepper; cook butter, crumbs and milk, add two well beaten eggs and mix all ingredients together; place in hot greased pan and bake fifteen minutes. Serve with cream sauce made thus: One tablespoon flour, one of butter, rubbed to a smooth paste; add one cup milk and stir and cook five minutes; season.

JEFFERSON IS RETIRED

Noted Actor Compelled by Old Age to Abandon Stage and Live Quietly.

SEVENTY YEARS AN ACTOR

After an Attack of Illness Joseph Jefferson Has Decided to Attempt the Stage No More, but Return Home.

New York, Oct. 1.—Joseph Jefferson, after more than 70 years on the stage, during which time he has become one of the most honored and beloved members of the dramatic profession, has decided absolutely never to resume his theatrical career. Mr. Jefferson arrived here from Boston, where he had rested a few days, recuperating his recent illness at Buzzards bay which caused the abandonment of his fall tour.
He is convalescent but still must be judicious in guarding his returning strength, and will remain here three weeks, after which he will go by easy stages to Florida, stopping in Washington for a time and again in Atlanta.
When the decision was ultimately reached he quietly announced it to his family.
"I shall never act again," he said. "My days upon the stage are ended." Once the decision was made and its first feeling of solemnity had passed, Mr. Jefferson became more cheerful.
"It will seem strange at first to act no more," he added, "but I shall soon get used to that and I shall begin to enjoy what I have looked forward to these many years—my long, long holiday, in which I shall enjoy uninterceptedly nature in outdoor life, my paintings, my books and pleasant companionship with wife, children and dear friends. I begin my holiday at last."

Paterson, N. J., was the city where he last appeared. The performance was in June, and, as an odd coincidence took place not far from his quaint old summer home, Hohokus, where the actor resided between seasons for 30 years.
