Chicago Woman Takes Policies for \$500,000.

> Chicago, Oct. 13 .-- Mrs. Charles Netcher, owner of a down town department store, is following in the footsteps of her late husband. When he decided to build on his property he insured his life for \$500,000 so that in the event of his death his plans might not be interfered with.

Mrs. Netcher having taken up the burden dropped by her husband on June 20, when he died, has decided to do likewise. Four large insurance com-

panies in the east have adgeed to issue a \$500,000 policy on her life. One company will take \$200,000 of the risk and the three others \$100,000 each.




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
