WAITERS STOLE ABOUT \$10,000

Hotel Rathskeller in New York Victimized by Its Dining Room Force.

CHECK GIRL WAS IN THE PLOT

Hotel Was Surrounded by Officers After Detectives Had Secured Evidence, and Waiters Were Arrested.

New York, Nov. 4.—Several hundred after-theater diners at the Marlborough hotel rathskeller have been thrown into a state of excitement dangerous to a good digestion by the descent of a squad of police, who blocked every exit while detectives made prisoners of half a dozen waiters charged with defrauding the management. It is stated by the latter that at least \$10,000 had been stolen when the plot was discovered. There had been a long search for the leakage in the receipts. It was finally learned that the checks were being tampered with and a girl whose duty it was to mark and check the waiters' tabs, was found to be implicated. In order to pick out the waiters involved, a police captain and detectives spent several hours at the restaurant tables. When they had concluded observations, a signal was given and men in uniform, approaching with drawn revolvers from the outside, blocked all the doors. The guilty waiters were panic stricken, and dropping dishes filled with food, attempted to escape. The young woman checker also was arrested and is said to have confessed to receiving one-seventh of the profits from which she had saved several hundred dollars. She declared one of the men had drawn her into the plot by threatening her with a revolver. A great crowd was drawn to the scene and blockaded Broadway for some time.
