San Francisco, Nov. 28.—The schooner Lizzie Prien, which sailed from here last night for Eureka, ran ashore about one mile south of the Cliff house. She was pulled off early this morning.

AMOUNT IS EXAGGERATED.

London Defalcation Did Not Reach Sum of \$5,000,000.

London, Nov. 28.—Lord Rothschild, when questioned today by a representative of the Associated Press regarding the alleged embezzlement of \$5,000,000 by Moses Blumenthal, said to have been head of the bullion department of the London house of the Rothschilds,

who incensed at what he termed "such gross exaggeration," but otherwise declined to discuss the matter.

The defalcation occurred in July, not a few weeks ago, as cabled to the United States, and it was stated at the time that the shortage was in the neighborhood of \$150,000. The whole matter was settled privately shortly after the embezzlement was discovered.
