

BUTTER VERY FIRM

Poorer Grades in Great Variety at Good Prices.

Japanese Oranges Are Plenty in the Local Markets on Account of the Coming of Chinese New Year. Good Prices at Retail.

Portland, Jan. 26.—First quality butter is very firm, but the poorer grades are considered weak. Fancy grades are held as high as 30 cents a pound on front street today, while 3 1/2 cents is demanded for "extra fancy" turned out by the city creameries.

Heavy receipts of Japanese oranges mark the wholesale fruit stocks today. These little oranges come from Kobe and pay a duty of 1 cent a pound on landing in the United States.
